



PAMPERED PET BOARDING---RELEASE FORM

Thank you for choosing BAH Pampered Pets Boarding Facility to board your pet! If your pet has never boarded with us or has not been examined by our veterinarians in the last 12 months, we will require a physical exam while your pet is here.

Your pet will be checked for intestinal parasites at your expense every 6 months unless currently taking monthly heartworm prevention, then your pet will be checked annually. If your pet is found to have intestinal parasites, he/she will be treated at your expense to ensure their comfort and to prevent the spread of parasites.

All pets are watched closely and are boarded in separate rooms to minimize contact. Pets suffering from anxiety will be treated for this condition to minimize damage to property and to themselves. If your pet injures itself while boarding; we will treat them at your expense. We will do everything that we can to ensure your pet has a pleasant stay at Benning Animal Hospital.

VACCINATIONS: All pets boarding at Benning Animal Hospital or Pampered Pets Boarding Facility must have proof of current vaccinations for distemper/parvo, rabies, and bordetella. The bordetella should be given at least 2 weeks prior to boarding to be completely effective. We can, however, administer the bordetella at the time of your pet's arrival, but your pet may still be susceptible to bronchitis or upper respiratory infection.

FLEA/TICK PREVENTION: To ensure that the spread of fleas does not occur in our facility, we will be treating **all** boarders with a capstar pill upon arrival, unless you are already administering **monthly** flea prevention (i.e. comfortis, Vectra, trifexis). You may opt to purchase a comfortis tablet (lasts for 30 days) that will be administered with your pet's first meal. If your pet needs tick prevention, we can provide this also. Just ask your receptionist for pricing.

BEDDING: Your pet will be boarded in a private room and will be exercised in a large fenced area at least 3 times a day. We will provide a nice, plush bed for your pet to relax on, but if you would rather they had their own bedding from home, you are more than welcome to bring it. We try to keep all bedding clean; still their personal belongings may get confused with ours during the cleaning process.

FEEDING: Your pet will be fed a quality food. If your pet does not eat our food, we will try canned or special food to encourage them and ensure good nutrition. If we have to continue this special feeding, you will incur additional charges. If you wish to bring your own food, we will feed according to your instructions.

MEDICATIONS: If your pet is on medications, we will give them according to your instructions. There is a medication fee of \$3.25 per day

BATHING AND NAIL TRIMS: As a courtesy, if your dog(s) stay is for 7 nights or longer, they qualify for a "Bath on the House". They will be bathed with our Cherry Blossom shampoo the night before pick up. The Bath on the House does not include nail trims, brush outs, anal gland expressions or ear cleaning, but you may request to have these services done. Unfortunately, cats and aggressive dogs will not qualify for a Bath on the House. If your pet(s) stay is less than 7 nights you may request a bath or additional services, just let your receptionist know. If your schedule changes, please notify us so we can have your pet ready for you.

PAYMENTS: We accept payment the day you drop off. If your pet is here for long-term boarding (over 10 nights), we require a credit card number on file. Any additional charges must be paid the day you pick up before your pet will be released to you.

HOURS OF OPERATION: We are open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 7:30 am until 6:00 pm, Wednesday 7:30 until 5:00 pm, Saturday 8:00 am until 3:00 pm. We are closed for lunch Saturday from 12:00 pm until 12:45pm. We are closed from 12:30 pm until 2 pm on the second Tuesday of every month. We are closed all day on Sunday!
