**DENTAL RELEASE—PRE-ANESTHETIC TESTING**

Your pet is scheduled for a procedure that requires anesthesia. We would like to take this opportunity to recommend pre-anesthetic testing and explain why it is important to the health of your pet.

Like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Before placing you pet under anesthesia a veterinarian will perform a complete physical examination to identify any medical conditions that could complicate the procedure and compromise the health of your pet. **If your pet has any intestinal or external parasites, we will treat these at your expense.**

Because there is always the possibility that a physical exam alone will not identify all of your pet's health problems we strongly recommend pre-anesthetic bloodwork. The tests we recommend are similar to and equally important as those you own physician would run if you were to undergo anesthesia.

It is important to understand that a pre-anesthetic profile does not guarantee the absence of anesthetic complications. It may, however, greatly reduce the risk of complications as well as identify medical conditions that could require treatment in the future.

- CBC (anemia/red blood cell, infection/white blood cell clotting/platelet)

**THIS OPTION IS MANDATORY FOR PETS 7 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER,** but we highly recommend this for pets of any age.

**PAIN MEDICATION** (This is \$5-\$20 depending on the weight of the animal)

Pain medication is required for this procedure. This includes a pill form of pain medication for dogs and a liquid form of medication for cats.

**E.C.G \$46.00** YES \_\_\_\_\_ NO \_\_\_\_\_ The E.C.G. reading will give the doctor(s) information on the condition of your pet's heart. E.C.G. can detect problems such as enlarged ventricles, valve problem, electrical conduction problems, which may cause your pet to be more sensitive to anesthesia. Cardiologist view the E.C.G. results prior to surgery, then fax the results to us. They let us know if your pet is healthy enough to undergo surgery or if we need to give any special injections prior to, or during surgery. **THIS IS MANDATORY FOR PETS 7 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER.**

**MICROCHIP \$32.00** YES \_\_\_\_\_ NO \_\_\_\_\_ Microchip identification is a positive way to identify ownership, if your pet is lost or stolen (not to be confused with GPS) and ends up in a shelter, veterinary clinic, or animal control facility.

**FLEA/TICK PREVENTION \$9.25** As part of our flea-free policy, any animal coming in for surgery, baths, drop offs, boarding, etc. will automatically be treated with a capstar pill. This is to ensure your pet does not go home with fleas. If your pet is found to have ticks a tick treatment will be applied at your expense.

**VACCINATIONS** All animals staying for surgery must be current on vaccinations. Dogs are required to have rabies, dhlpp, and bordetella. Cats are required to have rabies and fvrpc.

**EXAM \$15.00** All animals must have a current examination with in the last six months by our veterinarian. Also if your pet is here for a surgery or dental and this procedure has not been recommended by one of our doctors you pet will be examined by a veterinarian prior to the procedure being preformed.
